



Finishing Touches made to Esperanza's New Elementary School



Boerne ISD has made their finishing touches on the design details of **Dr. Ferdinand L. Herff Elementary School** which will be located in the Master Planned Community of Esperanza in Boerne, TX. The developers of Esperanza, [The Lookout Group](#), donated land to Boerne ISD in anticipation of building a neighborhood school, and in May 2016 the voters overwhelmingly approved a bond package to do just that. Boerne ISD is one of the fastest growing school districts in Texas.
